You don't need to be psychic to use it—just willing to listen, trust, and open your heart to the messages waiting to be revealed.

Use this deck as a daily companion or as a source of light during difficult times. Shuffle with intention, pull a card, and let Spirit speak. You are never alone. You are always guided. And the answers will come—exactly when you're ready to receive them.

The Spirit Message Spread

This spread is designed to open a channel between you and Spirit, providing insight into your current situation, the unseen influences around you, and the divine guidance you most need to hear right now.

How to Use the Spread:

Begin by holding your deck to your heart and silently asking, *"Spirit, what do you want me to know?"* Shuffle until you feel ready, and then draw five cards face down and place them in a row. Turn them over one at a time, letting each card speak to your spirit. Interpret them according to the placements below. Write down impressions, journal your insights, or simply sit with the energy of the reading.

Let this spread be your conversation with the Divine. You asked—and Spirit is answering.

Card Meanings:

1. Your Energy Now

What energy or emotion you are currently holding. This sets the tone of the reading.

2. What Spirit Sees

The deeper truth of your situation from a higher perspective—what you may not yet see.

3. The Message

The central message Spirit wants to deliver to you today. Listen with your heart.

4. What to Let Go Of

A thought, fear, or block that is interfering with clarity or peace.

5. The Path Forward

A step or insight to help you move forward in alignment with your highest good.

Card Meanings and Interpretations

Look up each card meaning below alphabetically by the title on the card. There are Yes/No meanings, Love Guidance, and Money Advice for each one.

Sometimes less is more. Choose ONE card and focus on it for the day, or keep it out for a while until the meaning becomes clear to you.

The Abyss

In-Depth Meaning:

The sky is black velvet, pinpricked with stars, but you can't see them now—not while you're tumbling. Down, down, down into the unknown. There are no walls, no floor, no handholds. Only the sensation of falling endlessly through the dark. It feels terrifying. You've lost your orientation, your direction, your certainty.

Everything you thought you could count on has crumbled. You are suspended in a space between what was and what will be, stripped of distractions, illusions, and even your identity.

And yet, it is here—in this vast and formless void—that your soul begins to whisper. Without the noise of the outside world, you start to hear something deeper: truth. Your truth. This abyss isn't a punishment. It's a portal. What falls away wasn't meant to stay. What remains is the essence of who you really are. This is the Well of the Soul, and you have not been abandoned—you have been summoned.

The Abyss teaches that surrender is not the same as defeat. It is a sacred release, an invitation to be remade. Once you stop struggling and start listening, you will feel the soft current beneath you, lifting you toward the light. The deeper you go into yourself, the higher you rise.

Yes/No Interpretation:

Love Interpretation:

Any Direction

In-Depth Meaning:

Imagine standing in the middle of a great open field, the horizon stretching infinitely in every direction. There's no map, no signposts, no one to guide you—only the wide sky above and the soft earth beneath your feet. You're frozen by the sheer magnitude of choice. What if you pick the wrong way? What if you miss the best path?
